DINING AND MEETING



HOPEWELL HALL is our signature facility. Nestled beside a pine grove, the newly constructed building is heated and air conditioned for year-round use and offers a spacious setting for any type of gathering. The dining area features a cathedral ceiling with chandelier lighting for an open and airy atmosphere. The large stone fireplace is centered between ceiling length windows which provides an attractive focal point for the room and a picturesque view of the outdoors. It has a seating capacity of 260 people and is equipped with a state of the art sound and video system for movie, slide show, or power point presentations.

Hopewell Hall also has a meeting room with a capacity of 90 people that can be divided into two rooms to suit the needs of our guests. The gift shop offers apparel and keepsakes to remember your special time on our grounds. (See Delaware Lodge for additional year-round meeting space.)

OVERNIGHT LODGING

If you are interested in overnight lodging, **Otyokwah** offers these options:



DELAWARE LODGE is a one level building with a full length front deck that faces Hopewell Hall, Mingo Lodge, and our scenic valley. It is heated and has six separate dorm style rooms with a total capacity of 76. The Commons meeting room can seat up to 50 people and the lodge is equipped with four full restroom facilities. Delaware Lodge makes an excellent place for housing overnight guests for your camp, retreat, or special event.



MINGO LODGE is a small, cozy lodge that is nestled beside Hopewell Hall. The front porch overlooking Memorial Lake adds to the peaceful setting. It is heated and has a fully equipped kitchen, seating area, five sleeping rooms, and two separate restroom facilities. This lodge offers an intimate atmosphere for small groups up to 10 people. A small campfire ring is available off the front porch.

THE CABINS.

If you enjoy a natural, rustic, outdoor experience, our cabins are placed in the woodlands of our hills and are within walking distance to Hopewell Hall. They are a non-heated, one-room style with bunk beds. Restrooms are available through use of our Shower House.

SEASONAL MEETING PLACES



Otyokwah offers our **Chapel** with a seating capacity of 70. This non-heated, A-frame building provides a lot of rustic charm. If you prefer to worship outdoors, we have several campfire sites and the following options.....

Our peaceful and serene **Quiet Hour Ledge**, a small outdoor auditorium, features rustic wooden benches that overlook Memorial Lake and the valley below.



For a more secluded experience, we encourage you to hike up **Vesper's Hill**. At its summit, it features a Cross on the hillside nestled in the trees that provides a picturesque vista of the surrounding countryside.
